Competition Rules

1 Session Timings

This is an exceptionally busy meet and acknowledging both Guernsey Clubs are travelling on the day we still need to run within a time frame of approximately 10.15 to 5.00 pm including a short break at around 1.15 pm for lunch.

2. Heats and One Start Rule

1. One start rule.
2. Events will be swum slowest to fastest.
3. All Events will be Heat Declared Winners.
4. All Heats will be spearheaded.

3. Age Groups

As at 31st December and single age groups
9yrs / 10yrs / 11yrs / 12yrs / 13yrs/ 14yrs

4. Explanation of A and B Divisions

‘A’ and ‘B’ designations are there to encourage swimmers who might not normally feature on the podium. Every swimmer will have a designation for each event, based on their entered time. It is common for a swimmer to enter as an ‘A’ swimmer in several events and as ‘B’ in others. For each event you will find the relevant cut off time later in the program. This applies to all age groups except the 9 year olds where there is no distinction.

5. Awards and Presentations

Medals & Certificates

‘A’ Group - Medals 1st, 2nd and 3rd as age groups

‘B’ Group - Medals 1st, 2nd and 3rd as age groups but if a swimmer, entered as ‘B’ in an event improves better the cut off time by 3 or more seconds then a Speeding Ticket is issued, as opposed to a medal awarded. This is indicated by an ‘X’ in the results

Medals to be collected from the awards desk during the course of the meet, by an official from the swimmer’s Club.

All competitors will receive a certificate within three weeks of the meet recording their achievement. This will include any Speeding Tickets.

Trophies

There are top boy and girl trophies for the highest number of points accumulated during the meet – all swims to count.

Discretionary

For each Club - one boy / one girl we have a set of quality kit items. Nominations will be accepted from each head coach or senior official towards the end of the day. Their decisions will be based on criteria which include team commitment and support for team mates, exemplary behaviour and attitude, wearing of club kit, and achievement in relation to ability.

1. All entries will be Graded either A or B based on the entry times submitted
2. The entry form must be signed by a club official to acknowledge that he/she has read the conditions of the championship and certifies the entered times.
3. Once entries are accepted no refunds will be allowed.
4. If entered for a particular event at ‘Southernns’ in 2011 and/or if holding a national time in any event, entries are still very welcome but those event entries will be regarded as ‘exhibition’ and will not be eligible for a medal award or indeed count for points towards the overall trophy. However and to encourage all swimmers to attend with their teams, the meet has been designated so all times recorded will be registered with the ASA but in applying a selective exhibition status this still leaves those who might not ordinarily feature on the podium with the opportunity to do so.

7. Promoters Rights

The Promoter reserves the right to make such alterations to these conditions as may be considered necessary and/or to refuse entry. The 2011 Promoter is Mrs. Ailie Paterson.

8. Referee's decision

The decision of the referee(s) will be final.

9 General

Result sheets will be available for a small charge – these will also be posted in the Competitions Area at www.jerseyswimmingclub.com by 6 pm on Sunday 26th June.

Possessions and articles should not be left unattended as the promoters and pool management will not accept liability for any loss or damages that may occur during this meet.

Any conditions not covered in these competition rules will be dealt with in accordance with the laws of the sport and at the discretion of the Promoter.

If anyone wishes to use videos or take photographs during the duration of the Championships he/she must ask the permission of the Promoters at the beginning of each session and sign in with name and address details in the Log Book provided.
